Guest Speaker, Rev. Dr. Anna M. Robbins

This morning we extend a very warm welcome to our Guest Speaker, Dr. Anna Robbins, Acadia Divinity College President. Dr. Robbins earned her BA from Carleton University, two Masters Degrees from Acadia and her PhD from a University in Wales. Near the end of her doctoral studies, she was appointed to the faculty of the London School of Theology in the UK, where she served for twelve years as a teacher and academic leader. Dr. Robbins returned to Nova Scotia in 2012 to join the faculty at Acadia Divinity College, holding various faculty positions before becoming President in 2019. In addition to being President of ADC, Dr. Robbins is also Dean of Theology at Acadia University and sits in the Dr. Millard R. Cherry Chair of Theology, Ethics and Culture. In addition to these responsibilities, she is also the first Director of the Andrew D. MacRae Centre for Christian Faith and Culture, and serves on the Board of Directors of the Association of Theological Schools. Dr. Robbins has an international profile and continues to write, travel and speak widely, and we are thankful that she has taken the time to share with us today.
