## Rev. Dr. David Watt - Anniversary Speaker Next Sunday

We will be privileged next Sunday morning to have Rev. Dr. David Watt as guest speaker for our Anniversary Service. David has had a multitude of ministerial roles over many years, since graduating from Acadia with his Bachelor of Divinity Degree in 1965. Thirty-two of these years were spent ministering in rural, town and city churches in Nova Scotia, with one position as youth pastor at First Baptist in Calgary. Later, David served for six years, along with his wife, Florence, as Canadian Baptist Ministries Representative in Europe and the Mediterranean. He has also done adjunct teaching at Acadia Divinity College in Clinical Training, Supervised Field Education and Missions. From 2004 to 2010 David served at ADC as Recruitment Officer, Director of Development and Lecturer in Missions. David has worn many ministerial hats over the years, and this continues right up to the present, at the young age of eighty-three. He has recently finished a term of over two years as interim minister at Bedford Baptist, while continuing with his position as Part-Time Development Fundraiser at ADC, and his ministry as Chaplain at Oakwood Terrace Long Term Care Home. David wants us to know that, more important than any of these accomplishments, is the fact that he will very soon become a great-grandfather.
