There was also a budgeted amount for Canadian Baptist Ministries. In addition to this, our Women's Missionary Society (now disbanded) supported Partners in Mission, Jeff and Deanne Carter during their years in the Czech Republic and Bruno and Kathleen Soucy when they were in Rwanda.
