Guest Speaker Next Sunday, Sept 24 – Rev. Sharon Budd

It will be a great joy to welcome Sharon back to Digby Baptist next Sunday, Sept.24 as our guest speaker. Before being called to study for the ministry, Sharon attended Digby Baptist faithfully for twelve years while she was living and teaching in our town. In 1982, she left Digby to begin studies at Acadia Divinity College, graduating from there in 1986 after receiving her Master of Divinity and Master of Religious Education Degrees. Following her graduation, Sharon was immediately called to be the pastor of Melvern Square Baptist Church (near Middleton) where she served her entire pastoral ministry of twenty-six and a half years, retiring in 2013. Her ministry continued in another form when she returned to her childhood home in Beaver River (near Yarmouth) to be a caregiver to her mother, until her mother's death in 2018. Sharon continues to enjoy her retirement, still living in her childhood home in Beaver River and still preaching, but only once a month. We at Digby Baptist are blessed that she had not already committed to a Sunday in September when she was very recently approached to come and share with us next Sunday.
