Terry's sister-in-law, Boneta, along with members of her family, are among the evacuees. Margo Nesbitt's son, Colton, and his family have been evacuated from their home in Fort McMurray, AB, because of the wildfire threatening that city. The family was also evacuated during the 2016 fire.
